## Improving Your Grade Through Remote Learning

This week you are going to have the opportunity to choose how you would like for your grade to be determined in each of the courses you are taking this semester. One of the options you can choose is to work to improve your grade through remote learning from May $11^{\text {th }}$ to June $4^{\text {th }}$. If you choose this option, grades will be issued for the remote learning assignments and averaged with your current $3^{\text {rd }}$ quarter grades.

For Math 3, the Khan Academy tasks would factor into your current grade as follows:

| Grade Category (Percentage of <br> Overall Grade) | Khan Academy Assignments |
| :---: | :---: |
| Tests (65\%) | Three quizzes will be assigned in Khan Academy during this 4 week time <br> period. Each quiz will count as $1 / 3$ of a test grade (i.e. the average of the <br> 3 quizzes will become a test grade). |
| Quizzes (30\%) | Practice sets will be assigned twice a week. At the end of each week the <br> grades for each practice set will be averaged. This grade will count as a <br> quiz grade. |
| Classwork/Homework (5\%) | Lesson videos and articles will be assigned twice a week. At the end of <br> each week the percentage of your completed tasks (noted by check marks) <br> will be entered as a classwork/homework grade. |

On June $4^{\text {th }}$ we will determine if you were able to improve your grade through your engagement in remote learning or not. You will receive the higher of the March $13^{\text {th }}$ and the June $4^{\text {th }}$ grade as your final numerical average.

Note: If you end-up earning a borderline grade (e.g. 89.2) as of June $4^{\text {th }}$, we will factor in your completion of remote learning work from March $13^{\text {th }}$ to May $11^{\text {th }}$ and/or your completion of the Trig Project to make a decision.
